- Parents and siblings are welcome to cheer on students and even run with them if they wish (please refer to the PACER schedule for your child's class time slot). Guests must be approved St. Johns County volunteers (no exceptions) and are encouraged to register in advance via the form at the bottom of this page. They will need to check in on PACER day with a photo ID.
- Donations/pledges can be on a per-lap basis or a flat dollar amount. Pledges may be turned in on the attached paper form and/or via 99Pledges Online Pledging (instructions attached).
- You may accept donations in both forms and we will combine them on our end.
- Please keep donations to a minimum of 25 cents per lap or \$1 flat donation.
- Pledge forms are due back to the school **NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 20.**
- PCES volunteers will record each child's number of laps on their pledge form, which will be returned home that night for donation collection.
- All pledged donations are due by **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 27.**

### **2018 PUMA PACER - ONLINE DONATIONS THROUGH 99PLEDGES.COM**

We are pleased to be accepting online donations for the 2018 Puma Pacer via 99pledges.com.

1. Go to <https://99pledges.com/fund/2018pumapacer>
2. At the bottom of the page, click on "Add Participant".
3. Fill in the information on the pop up window, which will include your child's name, an email address (if you choose) and your child's grade. When you have completed this information, click the "Add" button. Repeat steps 1-3 as needed.
4. In order to get your customized donation URL, go to "Search For Participant" on the main fundraiser page, and type in your child's name. This will take you to their personal fundraising page. You may then copy the URL that appears in the browser bar and send that out via email, text or social media.
5. If people would like to donate, all they have to do is click the big "donate" button and fill out the desired amount and payment information!
